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**CRITERIA FOR LGBTQ YOUTH JUSTICE BURSARY**

The following is a list of criteria for the Toronto Police Services LGBTQ Youth Bursary Award:

- The award is to be granted to a LGBTQ youth between the ages of 17 and 26 years.
- The award is to be used exclusively for post-secondary educational tuition costs. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution.
- The award is to be granted for contributions to LGBTQ community in the area serviced by Toronto Police Services.
- To be eligible for the award, nominees must be a Canadian citizen, landed immigrant or have refugee status.
- Past bursary recipients are amazing, but no longer eligible.
