RE: Notice of Termination of Paid Duty for Wide Load Escorts

In February 2017, the Toronto Police Services Board approved recommendations from the Transformational Task Force to modernize policing in the City of Toronto (City) including changes to the Paid Duty Program.

Consequently, effective August 1, 2017, all wide load permits issued in the City of Toronto will cease to require Paid Duty policing escorts. Instead, Toronto Transportation permits will mandate the requirement for a licensed "pilot vehicle". This "pilot vehicle" is to be provided by the trucking service company. The City does, however, reserve the right to impose paid duty requirements in exceptional circumstances.

Paid Duty customers that have funds being held in trust will receive reimbursements of any surplus funds following the settlement of any outstanding accounts, during the first week of September, 2017.
